

AWANA Club Structure: ages and expectations at each club

Cubbies

3 turning 4 in the academic year

4 turning 5 in the academic year

Child is able to sit and listen for 10 minutes at a time

Parent stays if the child is not able to sit and listen for 10 minutes at a time

Expected to work with parent weekly on workbook and verse memory

Mus be able to use the restroom independently

Sparks - K-2 grade

Child is 5 turning 6 in the fall or winter

Expected to sit and listen\work for 15 minutes at a time

Expected to memorize multiple verses and sections

Parent help required in workbook

Two or three helps allowed in verse recitation

T&T - Grades 3-5 (8 turning 9 in the academic year to 11)

Expected to sit and listen as directed by leaders

Expected to memorize multiple full and/or larger verses and sections

Expected to recite section reviews without stopping

Parent help required in workbook

One or two helps allowed in verse recitation

TREK -Grades 6-8

Expected to sit and listen as directed by leaders

Expected to complete daily verse reading and answer daily discussion questions prior to club night (written answers in workbook)

Expected to memorize multiple full and/or larger verses and sections

Expected to recite section reviews of seven verses without stopping

One help allowed per verse recitation
